First Generation

1. Terrence “Canty” Kenty. Born in 1751 in Cork Co., Ireland. Terrence “Canty” Kenty died in Truro Road, Summerfield, Nova Scotia, on 22 Jan 1829; he was 78. Buried in Grand Lake, NS (private burial site). Occupation: Corps of Orange Rangers, Ireland; Sgt. Loyal N.S. Regiment 1778-1781; 1784/Honourable Discharge.

Terance Canty on the marriage bond to Elizabeth Leppert (NSHVS)

From Chamberlain and Kenty (2003):

Origin of the name in IRELAND: EN CHANTEIGH (Gaelic), a descendent of Chantaigh the satirist, progenitor of the family in the County of Cork, Ireland in the early 16th century. “A bardic family” (poets, singers, harpist) belonging to West Cork, Ireland, which produced some well known poets as Fearfasa O'Canty, 1610, who was concerned with the Contention of the Bards in the early 17th Century. Derivatives: en Chantie (Gaelic) 16th C. en Enchantie (Anglicized).

Modern: O'Canty, Canty- recorded in survey of Armagh County 1618, anglicized in Counties Kerry & Limerick.

Nova Scotia: Kenty, Canty, McKenty.

LAND GRANT DOCUMENTS; Petition Terence Kenty for Grant of Land Cobequid Rd 5th of June 1808. With permission of the Crown he lived on these lands for 7 years and cleared 7 acres of land. Warrant: Lying into Terence Kenty 500 acres, 24th of November 1810. Sgd. Sir George Provost, Baronet, Lieutenant Governor, Province of Nova Scotia.

An Order- Lying out 500 acres of land on road to Truro being the same one on which the family resided and recently escheated. Sgd Sir John Cape Sherbrooke, Lt. Gov. Nova Scotia 15th August 1812.

A grant of land from George III of Great Britain and Ireland to John James, born Truro Rd 1789, William and Terence II Kenty, in common with Jane and Margery Kenty, spinsters, containing 500 acres of land at Kenty's Cove, Great (Grand Shubencadie) Lake, Halifax Co. beginning at marked tree "T.K." etc. dated 24th September 1812.

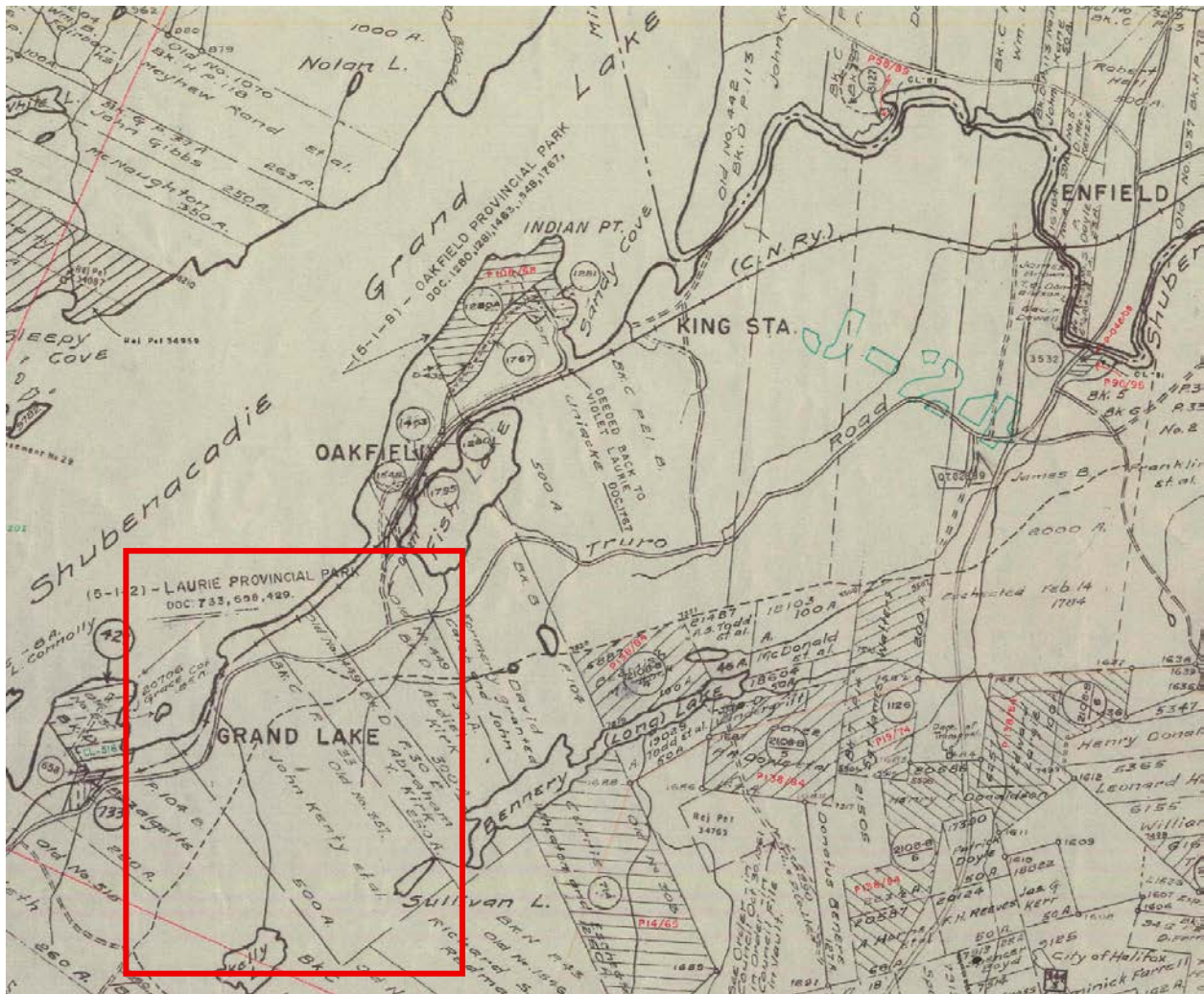
National Archives MG II Vol. 217155, B-1040, " State of His Majesty's Loyal Nova Scotia's Volunteer Regiment Commanded by Capt. Geo. Henry Monk, Jan. 1781, Mt. Pleasant, 9th of January 1781 shows CANTY as a private. The description of his unit's uniform is: Red coats with green lapels.

As the first family matured and became of marriageable age, most of Terence's family moved further inland to Nine Mile River, Gays River, Milford, Shubencadie and Elmsdale where the farmland was more fertile. Six of his children settled in Nine Mile River and four in Gays River. The wives and husbands of the Kenty Irish-Presbyterians were mostly Scottish Presbyterians, with others English and Welsh.

COAT OF ARMS. THE O'CANTY. MCKENTY, CANTY, KENTY COAT OF ARMS in in the form of a shield. In the upper left and right are half moons above a chevron. Another half moon is centered below the chevron. Colors of the Half moons and Chevron are light yellow on an azure ground. In Irish heraldry the arrangement refers to the Trinity. Descendents are entitled to use this Coat of Arms.

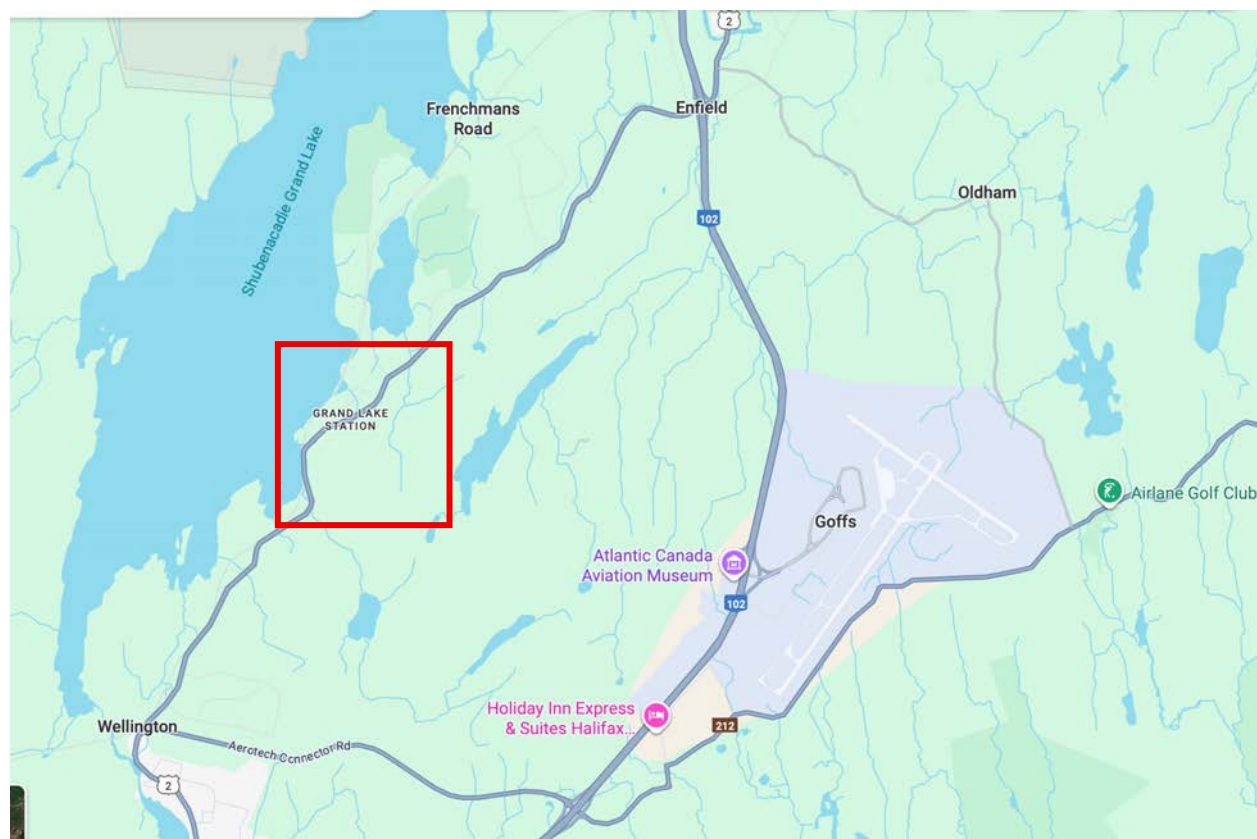

On 5 Sep 1780 when Terrence “Canty” was 29, he married **Elizabeth Leppart**, daughter of **Melchior Leppert**¹ (1721-16 May 1808) & **Catherine** (ca 1738-7 Sep 1826), in Halifax, NS. Born on 28 Mar 1761 in Lunenburg, NS. Buried in Grand Lake, NS.

They had the following children:

- i. **James Cameron**. Born in 1789. James Cameron died in Nine Mile River, Hants Co., NS, on 13 Jun 1847; he was 58. Buried in Nine Mile River Church Cemetery.

Raised nephew James Francis Kenty (Beulah Wright).

James Canty, first born of Terence & Elizabeth Leppart, lived out his days with spouse, Grizzle Fraser. They were married in Shubenacadie by Rev. Robert Blackwood 19 Jan 1819. The couple did not have children of their own, but were close to nieces and nephews as evidenced in James' will of 6 Nov 1846-Hants County. Over the years since his passing, the spelling of the Canty name came to be KENTY. (findagrave)

On 9 Jan 1819 when James Cameron was 30, he married **Grissella Fraser**, daughter of **James Fraser** (25 Dec 1753-16 Nov 1820) & **Margaret Cameron** (10 Feb 1762-), in Shubenacadie, Hants Co., NS. Born in 1790 in Nine Mile River, Hants Co., NS. Grissella died in Elmsdale, Hants Co., NS, on 25 Nov 1876; she was 86.

Grisella Canty, 86, widow, d/o James Fraser (NSHVS).

¹ **Melchior Leppert** was born in 1721 in Pfalz Palatinate, Rhineland Germany and died in Halifax, NS, on 16 May 1808; he was 87. Occupation: Baker. Residence: Arrived in Halifax on the “Pearl”, 1751. Settled in Lunenburg, 1760/Returned to Halifax. Melchior married **Catherine**, born ca 1738, died in Dutch Town, Halifax, NS, on 7 Sep 1826; she was 88. They had 10 children.

- The birth date of 1793 comes from Chamberlain and Kenty (2003) but that is not the David who md. Isabella Fraser, as they have recorded. This is his nephew David3, s/o John2, Terence1.
- iv. **Samuel**. Born in 1794.
- Chamberlain and Kenty (2003) have a son Samuel b. 1830, md. to Mary Jane, ch. James (1861), Hannah (1864) and Grissie (1870), no other details. I have not found Samuel in the primary records or on familysearch.
- In 1818 when Samuel was 24, he married **Molly Pollock**.

 vi. **Elizabeth**. Born in 1805.
- 4 vii. **Terence** (1807-)

- Nancy apparently never married, the 1881 Census renumeration for Nine Mile River shows her living with James and Mary Jane Kenty.

2. John Kenty (*Terrence "Canty"*¹). Born in 1790. John died in Shubenacadie, Hants Co., NS, on 20 Aug 1862; he was 72. Buried in Gays River Church Cemetery.

"The Presbyterian Witness and Evangelical Advocate" newspaper index records "John Kenty died Wed. 20 August at Shubenacadie, aged 71 years, 11 months" issue of Aug 23 1862."

John and Rachel's marriage bond in Halifax was dated 21 Feb 1815. John was living in the Cobequid area of Truro Twp. when they married. He signed "John Canty".

Rachel and John raised several children...Mary Ann Brown, David, John, James, Hannah Carroll, George William, Rachel Matilda Campbell, Griselda Keyes, Terrence, and Adam Esson.

Rachel Cummings was married to John Kenty, at the Grand Lake, and had a family of children. (Miller, Thomas)

On 1 May 1860 when David was 41, he first married **Isabella Fraser** in Shubenacadie, Hants Co., NS. Born in 1810 in Pictou County. Isabella died in Gays River, Col. Co., NS, on 26 Dec 1873; she was 63.

On 22 Mar 1875 when David was 56, he second married **Catherine Isenor** in Shubenacadie, Hants Co., NS. Born in 1822, d/o George and Hannah. Catherine died in 1915; she was 93.

On 3 May 1887 when William "George" was 56, he married **Catherine McDonald** in Truro, NS. Born on 21 Jul 1841 in New Glasgow, NS. Catherine died in Milford Station, Hants Co., NS, on 15 Nov 1915; she was 74. Buried in Gays River Church Cemetery.

Catherine was the daughter of Duncan & Grace MacDonald of Pictou county. Married twice.....first Catherine McDonald and Thomas Keys married 1880 in Pictou County. On 20 Sep 1866 when Grizzelda was 30, she married **Thomas Keyes**, son of **Thomas Keys** (1796-21 Feb 1875) & **Elizabeth Moore** (25 Aug 1798-23 Dec 1875), in Shubenacadie, Hants Co., NS. Born on 12 Sep 1825 in Shubenacadie, Hants Co., NS. Thomas died in Truro, Colchester Co., NS, on 27 Sep 1881; he was 56. Buried in Gays River Church Cemetery.

Thomas was one of many children of Thomas Keys Sr. and Elizabeth Moore. Married twice before he passed in 1881. First Grieselda Kenty and Thomas Keys married 1866 in Hants County Item can be found in Registration Year: 1866 - Book: 1823 - Page: 12 - Number: 137. Second Catherine McDonald and Thomas Keys married 1880 in Pictou County Item can be found in Registration Year: 1880 - Book: 1831 - Page: 204 - Number: 132. (findagrave)

- ix. **Adam Esson**. Born in 1839 in Grand Lake, NS. Adam Esson died in 1908; he was 69.

1871 census Shubenacadie Kenty Adam E 31 Mary Ann 32 Margery 7 Kenneth 3 Rachel 76.

Adam Esson Kenty was the youngest of 10 children born to John & Rachel Cummings Kenty in the Grand Lake area of Nova Scotia. When his father died in 1862, Adam was tasked with taking care of his mother by keeping the homestead up. His mother drafted an agreement that Adam signed promising to do so. Shortly after this, he married for the first of four times to Mary Ann McKenzie in 1863. He had four children by Mary Ann. Two of the sons died by 1873 and are buried with their grandparents in Gays River cemetery. The two other children, Margery Matilda and John Furlong, Adam, & Mary Ann moved to Lowell, MA. This was where Mary Ann died in 1886 and is buried. By this time Margery and John were on their own. Adam married three more times: 1888 in MA-Mary Cummings, 1904 in Nova Scotia-Elizabeth Grant Heighton, & in 1906 Mary Elizabeth Walker Reid Craven. The last marriage was in Kentville, Kings County, NS. There is yet no record of where he is buried. (findagrave)

On 13 Jan 1863 when Adam Esson was 24, he first married **Mary Ann McKenzie** in Shubenacadie, Hants Co., NS.

On 22 Sep 1904 when Adam Esson was 65, he second married **Elizabeth Heighton** in Stellarton, Pictou Co., NS.

3. Margery Kenty (*Terrence "Canty"*¹). Born ca 1802. Margery died in Glenholme, Colchester Co., NS, on 12 Jan 1860; she was 58.

On 24 Feb 1824 when Margery was 22, she married **Hugh McCully** in Londonderry Township, NS. Born in 1785. Hugh died in Londonderry Township, NS, on 18 Oct 1847; he was 62. Buried in Folly Village Cemetery.

They had the following children:

- i. **Mary Jane**. Born in 1829 in Masstown, NS. Mary Jane died in Truro, NS, on 7 Apr 1900; she was 71.

Mary Jane married **Thomas Johnson**. Born on 1 Feb 1824 in Truro, NS. Thomas died in Truro, NS, in 1900; he was 75.

On 16 Jul 1868 when Amos was 31, he married **Mary Jane Fulton**, daughter of **Charles Edward Fulton** (1816-1 Aug 1883) & **Margaret Giddens**, in Londonderry, Col. Co., NS. Born on 10 Jul 1846. Mary Jane died in Masstown, Col. Co., NS, on 12 Apr 1916; she was 69.

4. Terence Kenty (*Terrence "Canty"*¹). Born in 1807 in Grand Lake, NS. Terence died in Nine Mile River, NS.

The marriage to Belle Grant comes from Chamberlain and Kenty (2003), no other details,, and this has not been confirmed in any primary records.

Familysearch has Margaret Jane Kenty and John Kenty (the two oldest here) as the two ch. of Terence Kenty and Mary McMichael. No details on Mary. However, that seems to be confirmed by primary records.

They have Annie Wilson, Terrance Fitzgerald, Jane G. and Rebecca D. as the ch. of Terrance and Rebecca (Gould) Kenty.

In an era when great goaltenders were the rule, rather than the exception, Cecil (Tiny) Thompson didn't take a back seat to anyone.

The tag of Tiny was something of a misnomer; he stood 5-foot-10 and weighed around 170 pounds. His goaltending opposition at that time included such stalwarts as George Hainsworth, Roy Worters, Charlie Gardiner and Lorne Chabot, but he was still able to win the Vezina Trophy on four occasions -- 1929-30, 1932-33, 1935-36 and 1937-38.

Thompson was born in Sandon, B.C., May 31, 1903, and played his early hockey there. He also played amateur hockey for the Calgary Monarch Juniors, Pacific Grain Seniors, Bellvue Bulldogs and Duluth in the Minor Central League. He signed with Minneapolis in 1924, and played two years with them as an amateur then another two years with the same club when it turned professional.

Boston purchased Thompson and Cooney Weiland before the 1928-29 season. Tiny took over as the No. 1 goalie from Hal Winkler and remained with the Bruins for 10 seasons. He played his final two NHL seasons with Detroit, then retired. His lifetime average in league games was 2.08 and his playoff average of goals-against was 1.88 per game. In addition to his Vezina Trophy awards, Thompson was twice voted to the league's first All-Star team, and twice to the second team.

One of Thompson's most memorable matches was a classic marathon contest against Toronto in 1933 where, after a scoreless three regulation periods, he tended goal for another 104 minutes and 46 seconds of overtime before the Leafs won, 1-0, to take the quarter final series.
