John McMichael and his wife Jean Kerr and their children/grandchildren were part of the early settlers in the area of New Antrim Halifax County, and over to the Gays River area of Halifax/Colchester Counties. Since the McMichael's overlap with the McMullen's¹, from whom I descend, I have tried to compile all of the McMichael names I can from the Nova Scotia records. This report details the McMichael family as best I can at this time.

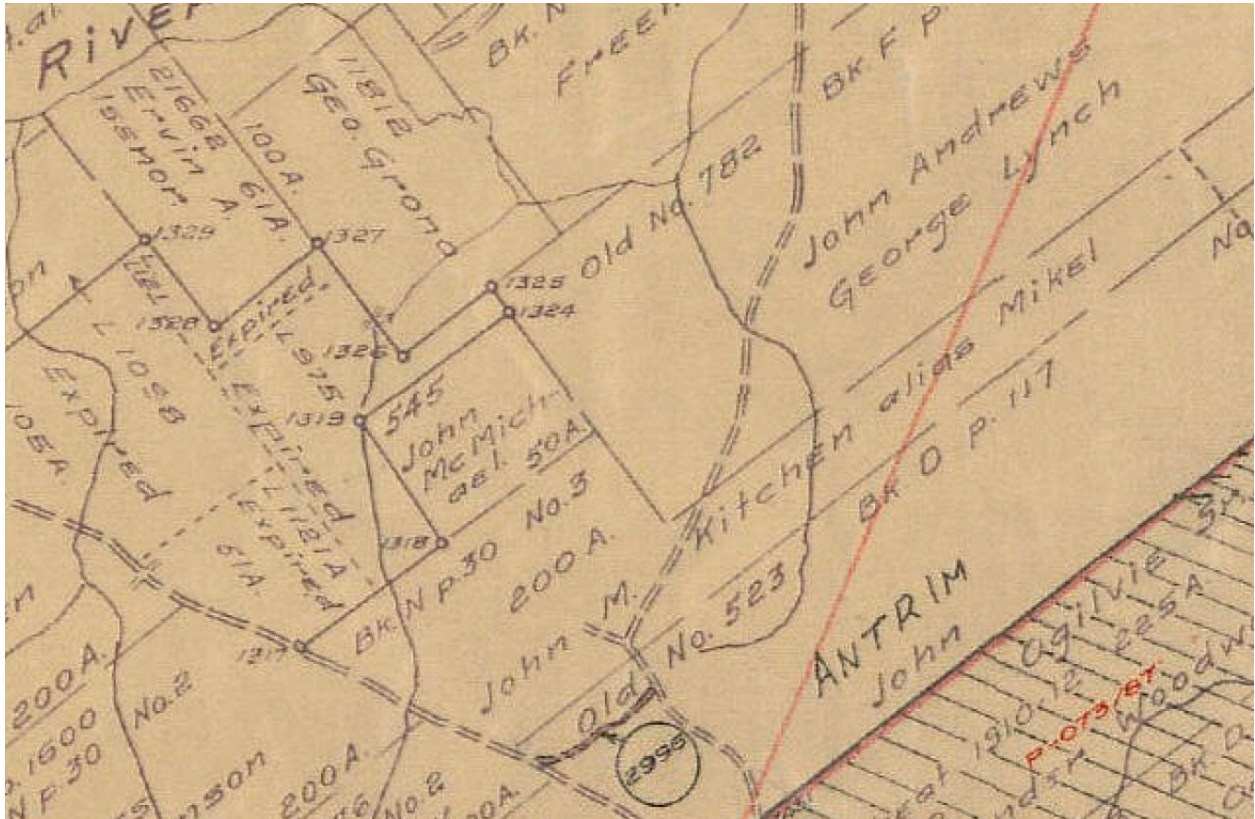

First Generation

1. John William McMichael. Born in 1780 in Ireland. John William died in New Antrim, Hfx. Co., NS, on 22 Jun 1867; he was 87. Widower, age 87, when he died (NSHVS deaths).

John William married **Jean Kerr.** Born in 1781. Jean died on 23 Aug 1862; she was 81.

John Kerr was an early settler in New Antrim, Halifax County, NS. Jean was perhaps a sister of John Kerr. They were of the same age. Please see my Kerr genealogy report.²

The children of John McMichael and Jean Kerr listed here are probably very incomplete, given that John Jr. was b. 1808 and Samuel and Keys were b. 1824 and 1826. There must have been several in between.

James McMichael, drowned 28 Oct 1841 Woodworth's Mill Pond, may have been a son.

Mary Ann McMichael (1822-1862) who married John Kerr Jr. is also possibly a daughter. She married John Kerr Jr.¹ If Jean (Kerr) McMichael was a sister of John Kerr Sr., then Mary Ann married her 1st cousin.

Gays River Church Cemetery, William Young d. 20 Sep 1867 age 61 years, a native of Aberdeenshire, Scotland, Martha McMichael d. 16 Sep 1867 aged 51 years. Possibly another daughter.

Samuel is a brother of Keys McMichael, information from Gays River cemetery records (Jerry Pace).

Samuel McMichael, Gays River, d. Mar 24, 1911, aged 86, married, born "Antrim", bur Gays River, S. George McMichael, informant of death (NSHVS Deaths). Note: Antrim, Halifax Co. or Antrim, Ireland - not specified.

Samuel married **Mary Thompson**. Born on 26 Sep 1829 in Nine Mile River, Hants, NS. Mary died in 1908; she was 78. Buried in Gays River United Church Cemetery, NS.

On the Stone in Gays River with Keys, Mary and Mary E., there is also Sarah E. McMichael, died Oct 9, 1867.

Son James, b. 1857, was found in NSHVS.

Obit 1949. Funeral Service Largely Attended. Gay's River, Nov 13 - The funeral of Samuel George McMichael, aged 81 years, took place from his home here last Tuesday. The service was largely attended. Mr. McMichael's death, which came after a brief illness was a shock to the community of which he was a life-long resident and one of the most successful and prosperous farmers. He was born at Gay's River May 1, 1868 and in 1902 married Eva Ford of Centre Burlington, Hants County. He was a member of the Gay's River United Church and took an active interest in its affairs. He was appointed Magistrate in 1910. He was a staunch Liberal all his life and in his passing the party lost one of its most active supporters. He leaves to mourn his wife, one daughter, Lucy Mary at home; one son, Austin Samuel and five grandchildren of Halifax; one brother, Arthur J. of Fort Worth, Texas. Interment was at Gay's River Cemetery with Rev. M. Nicholson officiating.

On 30 Jan 1902 when Samuel "George" was 33, he married **Eva Wilson Ford** in Burlington, Hants Co. Born in 1869 in Newburyport, Mass. Eva Wilson died in Gays River, Col. Co., NS, on 29 Jan 1960; she was 91. Buried in Gays River United Church Cemetery, NS.
