Preface

I will begin by saying that I am not a direct descendant of the Preepers. My family ran the Stage Coach Inn and Post Office at Goffs, a little further along the Old Guysborough Road from Devon where the Preeper's settled. I have traced the genealogies of all the families from that area that I do descend from, including along maternal lines – Goff, Dickey, MacInnes, McDougall and McMullen. They are all available from my website, www.gofffamilyhistory.ca . That led me to researching the genealogies of several overlapping families from the Guysborough Road – Dillman, Kellough, Kerr, Keys, McHeffey, McMichael and Moore, also available on the website above. There was considerable overlap Between Preeper's and Dillman's, so I decided to pull together all of the available online records for Preepers. This report is the result. Beside the Guysborough Road family, there was a branch of the family in Dartmouth and a branch that went to Colchester County, Londonderry and Portapique. Compared to the Dickey's or Dillman's, it is not a big family.

John William was the son of Ernest Jacob Tobias Preeper, born Germany, and his wife Wilhelmina Dorothea, born Germany, married 26 Nov 1751 St. John's Anglican Church, Lunenburg, she was married first to Gotlieb Rannenfelten. (familysearch)

Family of 12, familysearch. They have births of children at Windsor Road, Lunenburg Co.

On 30 Sep 1788 when John William was 33, he married **Mary Polley Brantley**. Born in 1762. Mary Polley died on 17 May 1836; she was 74.

The link to son Alexander may be tentative, as they also had a son John Alexander. There is cautionary note in familysearch under Alexander regarding his parentage.

On 11 May 1829 when William John was 27, he married **Martha Peveril**. Born in 1810 in Blackthorn, Oxfordshire, England. Martha died in Guysboro Road, Halifax Co., NS, in 1886; she was 76.

On 27 Dec 1832 when Robert F. was 24, he married **Susan Agnes Fletcher**, daughter of **Robert Fletcher** (1773-1830) & **Anne Brehm** (-1832). Born on 16 Mar 1809. Susan Agnes died in Portapique, Col. Co., NS, on 31 Oct 1877; she was 68.

Edith Fletcher, author of "Scotia Heritage", writes the following.... "the third youngest child of Robert and Anne, Susannah Fletcher (1809-Oct 31 1877) who married Robert Preeper, German origin, bachelor of the Windsor Road (Halifax Marriage Records). Her grave is located in the Portapique Cemetery. Perhaps as a widow she took her children to Portapique where her father's brother William Fletcher 2nd, resided (Jane Wile).

7. Alexander Preeper (*William John*², *John William*¹). Born on 14 Jun 1833 in Halifax, NS. Alexander died in Shubenacadie, Hants Co., NS, on 23 Jul 1892; he was 59. Buried in Preeper Hill, Shubenacadie, NS.

From familysearch, "Family records know that he lived and died in Schubencadie, Hants, Nova Scotia. He knew the McKilligan family and married Margaret Matilda McKilligan. The family has the marriage record written in Margaret's handwriting. There were other Preeper families in Halifax and several men were named Alexander Preeper. The family has no records of his parents names. His father was from England and died of smallpox in the pest hospital in Halifax. His mother remarried but we don't know his name. In her old age she lived with Alexander and Margaret in Shubenacadie."

1891 census Waverly Preeper George 53 Ch. of England Jemima 60 Baptist.

George Henry first married **Jemima Williams**.

From "History Along the Old Guysborough Road", by Noreen Gray and Annie (Blois) Smith, 1987, "In 1860 the Preeper farm was one of the largest and most prosperous on the Guysborough Road. The industry of its owner William Preeper was evident in the large neat house and barns. Preeper and his wife Mary Ellen raised a family of twelve. A lively household, the Preepers operated the Devon Post Office and usually boarded the Devon school teachers."

Born on 5 Jan 1866 in Spry Harbour, NS. Mary Ellen died in Devon, Halifax Co., NS, on 3 Feb 1934; she was 68.
