## Introduction

---

Robert and Margaret Moore were pioneer settlers on the Old Guysborough Road, in New Antim, Halifax Co., see obituary of daughter Fannie. They are buried in the Gays River Church Cemetery. The Kerr genealogy<sup>1</sup> stated that the Moore's (not the Gays River family), McFetridge's, Redmonds and McMullen's were all supposed to have come to Nova Scotia at the same time as the Kerr's. John Kerr was from the Kerr family of Clintyfinnan, (now Co. Derry) - see research done by Andrew Kerr of Cardiff, Wales - "The Carrstoon Kerrs". The McMullen's<sup>2</sup> came from Derrykeigan, Antrim (now Co. Derry), which is only 7 miles from the Clintyfinnan Road. Along with the McMullen's were the McFetridge's and the Redmond's, all who came from within the same small radius in Ballymoney and all settled on the Guysborough Road, "New Antrim", NS.

The reference to "not the Gays River Moore family" above suggests there were at least two Moore families in Gays River. Samson Moore (1730-1782) was a Grantee of Truro from Ireland, who emigrated first to Londonderry, New Hampshire. He married Martha Archibald in New Hampshire. She was a sister of all the Archibald's who settled in Truro. Samson Moore's family is detailed in the Miller book, (1873). Their son James Moore (1755-1818), md. Susan Teas, d/o Samuel Teas who was the second settler to the Stewiacke Valley in 1781, and James & Susan settled on the Shubenacadie River. Several of James and Susan's children are buried in Gays River Cemetery, and for this reason I have included a genealogy of their family as Appendix 1 of this report, p. 46, after the Index below. Their dau. Martha (1786-1874; d. Apr. 8, 1874, age 88) married "Samuel Moore of Gays River" (Thos. Miller, 1873). Samuel (1782-1851; d. Aug 7, 1851, age 69) was born in Coleraine, Ireland and was the son of George Moore of Coleraine, Ireland and Gays River, Nova Scotia<sup>3</sup>. Coleraine is only 8 miles from Ballymoney, and so it would seem that there could have been a familial connection between Robert Moore and George Moore.

Samuel and Martha (Moore) Moore had one daughter Susanna (1807-1849; (d. Mar 23, 1849 age 42) who married George Robert Logan (1791-1855 (d. Oct. 16, 1855, age 64, of Broomhedge, Ireland)<sup>4</sup>. See the fascinating biography of Samuel Moore and George Logan below. Samuel, Martha, Susanna and George Robert are all buried at the Gays River Church Cemetery.

In addition to son Samuel, George Moore had daughters Margaret (1796-7 Feb 1875) who

married John Keys (1794-1867), son of William Thomas Keys<sup>5</sup> & Isabella Clarke, and Elizabeth Moore (25 Aug 1798-23 Dec 1875) who married Thomas Keys (1796-1875), also a son of William Thomas Keys & Isabella Clarke. Margaret, John, Elizabeth and Thomas are all buried at the Gays River Church Cemetery.

Also at Gays River Cemetery, David Moore 1806-1878 (d. April 17, 1878, age 72) wife Margaret 1820-1879 (d. Oct. 23, 1879, age 59), Moore Margaret Jamesina, d/o David and Margaret 1859-1882. David was a son of James Moore and Susan Teas.

Gays River Cemetery, Moore Eliz. 1814-1878, (d. Dec. 26, 1878, age 64), wife of George Moore - She was Elizabeth Frame; George was a son of James Moore and Susan Teas.

So we actually have three Moore families in Gays River: Robert of New Antrim; George and three ch. Samuel Moore, and Margaret and Elizabeth Keys: and Samuel's wife Martha Moore and several of her siblings, ch. of James Moore, who was the s/o Samson of Truro.

SAMUEL MOORE ESQ. \*\* BORN IN COLERAIN, IRELAND IN 1782

For the News-

Mechanic, Mill-owner, Farmer, Postmaster, Storekeeper, Moneylender, Inventor, etc., etc.

About a year ago there appeared in the Truro News, a short sketch of the Manuel Training School at Grace Bay and a picture of the teacher at that school.

I thought at the time that he ought to take naturally to handiwork if there is anything in heredity. His father was a skilled workman in ship-carpentry and a master builder of houses. His grandfather on the maternal was in his time a "Genius in Wood-work". In this part of the country he was, in his early years, the only maker of the old wool spinning wheels, so much used sixty or seventy years ago. He also made flax-wheels, which was a more complicated business. He was a house carpenter, a cabinet maker, a mill and wheel-wright, often doing his own blacksmith work. And besides his handiwork, he was a music teacher, making his own tuning pipes and the notebooks for his pupils.

But the subject of this sketch is the great grandfather, Samuel Moore, whose daughter, an only child, was the wife of George R. Logan. We sometimes hear the remark made that a certain man is fifty years ahead of his time. It is just possible that Samuel Moore was nearer a hundred years ahead of his time.

He was born in Colerain, Ireland in 1782, descended on one side from a Huguenot family. His father, Geo. Moore, came to America when Samuel was about five years of age. They lived for a few years in the City of Boston, near where the State House now stands, but removed to Economy, Colchester County, where the descendants of William Moore (brother of George) still live.

They did not tarry long in Economy, but came further south. In 1796 George Moore bought two lots of land from Charles Dickson, of Onslow, Deputy Registrar. On this land, situated at Gay's River, he built a brick house and for a time kept an INN. This was the house where Rev. Mr. Dick held services at Gay's River, as may be seen from Rev. T. C. Jack's paper on Mr. Dick, at the late Maitland Centennial.

Samuel Moore was married about the age of 24 to Martha, daughter of James Moore, of Shubenacadie, a distant relative.

Not content with the few hundred acres of land which his father had deeded to him, he set himself to enlarge his estate, until it included thousands of acres, none of which he would ever sell. Half the inhabitants of Gay's River have farms now out of what was once his property. Soon after his marriage he built a fine house beside the main road, then the route of the mail coaches from Halifax to Truro and Pictou. The house is still "One of the Best" in the place, though now nearing the age of one hundred years.

Samuel Moore's farm was one of the best tilled and best kept of any between Halifax and Pictou. He was always experimenting in fertilizers, farm implements, and everything connected with farm work. He, with the assistance of his son-in-law, constructed machines very like the modern mowing and reaping machines.

Mr. Moore also built mills at Gay's River; a carding mill, which was the only one then in that part of the country; and a turning mill in which were turned hubs and spokes and "All Products" of the turning lathe required in making cars, wagons, spinning wheels and furniture. These mills (superintended by Mr. Logan) were a great benefit to the country and a source of pleasure and profit to the owner. Many an experiment made in wood and iron, many a wonderful bit of machinery of their own invention was turned out of that old time mill.

But, it was not only as a farmer and mill owner, that Mr. Moore was distinguished. He was well versed in geology-was always examining and studying rocks; for this, the study of insects and other purposes he procured a very fine microscope. He always maintained that there was gold in the "Rocks of Nova Scotia" even in Gay's River; and he always on the lookout for it. He was also an astronomer, and to aid him in this study, he bought two good telescopes, and much of his time was spent in studying the Heavenly bodies.

Samule Moore was a sculptor too, and a painter of no mean order. He made models of objects-the heads and faces of people in clay and plaster-which were very accurate in shape and features. He painted birds, fish, animals and men and women, wonderfully true to life.

He was his own lawyer, physician and dentist, and served in these capacities for others; for, though a busy man at home, he found time to serve the public in many ways, and he took keen interest in public affairs, though he scorned the "Shams and Humbugs" that too often characterize public life. Before railways were thought of for this Province he projected a railway from Halifax to Pictou; and, failing to interest the Government in it, he and a few others had part of the survey made at their own expense.

Mr. Moore was also the means of establishing a circulating library of useful books, which was a great benefit to the thoughtful readers of Gay's River and Shubenacadie. But his own library was the wonder of the time. It consisted of books on every conceivable subject and the leading periodicals of the day, Chambers Journal being one of the most prominent of the latter. With his books and the few newspapers then published, Mr. Moore spent many of his leisure hours.

A farmer, mechanic, mill-owner, postmaster, store-keeper, money-lender (he was the banker of the surrounding country), he was a "Prudent and Successful" man of business, and, at his decease, was worth a large amount of property. And although he lived not to see railways or any of the modern improvements on this country, they lived and worked in his busy brain; and in his dreams the miner brought up from the earth the black diamonds and the yellow gold in abundance.

Such was one of the men in the active scene of life when the last century was young. Men of the present day who think themselves well equipped if they are specialists in one department of the world's work. This man was a specialist in many; though he had no means of study but his own library.

We do not realize what we owe to our forefathers who, without schools or colleges or the many other opportunities or privileges of the present time laid "Bread and Deep" the foundations of knowledge, integrity and industry, and carved out a home in this, then new country, for themselves and the coming generations; and we fear we do not realize what we owe to the Great Father of all, for the many talents, opportunities and blessings with which He starts us and with which He supplies us all our lives long.

From Gays River Cemetery records, in the plot of Robert and Margaret Moore, last known owner Morris Moore, are Henry s/o Robert and Maggie and his wife Elizabeth (Tulley), Robert J., Sarah J. and Samuel, ch of Robert and Maggie, Robert James s/o Henry and Elizabeth and his wife Margaret

(Dillman), and Wells, Henry E. (1872-1873), Sara J. (b. and d. 1865), Martha E (1891-1892) and James H. (1874-1893), ch. of Samuel and Catherine.

Gays River Cemetery MOORE Robert J. Mar. 7, 1862 age 32 yrs, MOORE Sarah J. Sept. 20, 1828 age 19 yrs., children of Robert & Margaret MOORE (on same headstone). Note: she could not be born 1809 and be a d/o Robert b. 1804 and Maggie b. 1801.

Robert married **Margaret (Hamilton)**. Born in 1801 in Ireland.

Margaret Moore 75 married b. Derry Ireland d/o Robert Hamilton died 25 Nov 1876 New Antrim. Bur Gays River (NSHVS).

*This is likely the same person. If so, then I wonder if there was a connection to Catherine (McMullen) Moore's mother Martha Hamilton. Catherine married Samuel Moore (#3).*

An interesting news clipping found in the Bible of Morris Moore "Miss Fannie Moore of Antrim died very suddenly last Saturday. She was in her usual health up to within a few hours of her death. She is the last old land-mark gone from that place. Her youngest brother Samuel died a short time ago and Fannie was the last one of that large family. She was a fine old lady and will be greatly missed. The Moores, Moodys, Murphys and McMullins, all from Antrim, Ireland, who settled in New Antrim and made a good living for many years, raising large families, have nearly all disappeared from that place; some of the places have an old bachelor living on them with not a woman or a child for company." (undated, but Samuel died in 1903)

EMG remembers there was a connection between Samuel's son Morris and Robert's great-grandson James, md to Clara Smith, d/o James, s/o Robert Smith and Mary Moody.

On 3 Nov 1863 when Samuel was 22, he married **Catherine McMullin**, daughter of **Alexander McMullin** (1808-26 Jun 1893) & **Martha Hamilton** (1807-19 Dec 1865), in Halifax, Nova Scotia. Catherine died in Truro, Colchester Co., NS, on 2 Mar 1916; she was 70. Born on 12 Aug 1845 in Antrim, Halifax Co., NS. Buried in Gays River, Col. Co., NS. Residence: Douglas St., Truro (1916).

Recorded in the Truro Daily News is the marriage, 3 Nov. 1863, of Samuel Moore of Gays River to Catherine, 4th daughter of Mr. Alexander McMullin (sic) of the same place.

On the marriage bond, Alexander Smith (likely brother-in-law) was the witness.

1911 census Gays River, Moore Margaret head (W) 67 b. Nov 1843 Catharine (sic) sister-in-law 65 b. Oct 1845 Maurice son 35 b. Dec 1875.

(This must be Maggie (Dillman) Moore, widow of Robert James, s/o Henry and Elizabeth. It would be "Aunt-in-law" rather than sister-in-law, they were beside each other in the 1901 census).

Born on 1 Jan 1858 in Meaghers Grant, Hfx. Co., NS. Margaret died in Antrim, Halifax Co., Nova Scotia, on 21 May 1941; she was 83. Buried in Gays River Church Cemetery.

**Blue Jays 98-year-old superfan confident in team**  
**'It's a Canadian team, and I'm really a Canadian, and a Nova Scotian'**

As the Blue Jays biggest game in 23 years draws nearer, one of the team's biggest fans says there's no way they can lose.

Ninety-eight year old Alice Moore is decked out for today's big Blue Jays game. She's sporting her Blue Jays shoes, shirt and baseball cap.

Moore is keeping her cool, and her faith in her favourite team hasn't wavered.

"They're going to win, there's no doubt about it. With the enthusiasm that these young players have, and they're just going all-out today. There's no doubt about that and they're going to win."

Moore lives in a Shannex care home in the Halifax suburb of Clayton Park.

Henry Hicks was one of the most significant presidents in Dalhousie's 200-year history, overseeing nearly two decades of dramatic growth and change on campus. But he didn't do it alone. If Hicks is considered the architect of the modern Dalhousie, then **Alice Moore** (1917-2018), his executive secretary and confidant for 14 years, was the project manager.

Moore was born in Halifax three months before the 1917 Explosion. As she neared adulthood, she took a job at Eastern Canada Savings and Loans (the precursor to Central Trust) to help earn extra money for her family following the death of her father. Starting as secretary, she rose through the ranks to become department head.

She also met her future husband, Morris, at the company — on her first day of work, no less. They worked together in the same building for years, but when the company implemented a policy forbidding husbands and wives working together, Moore was let go.

She was devastated, but her supervisor had an inside track on another opportunity: Dal's president was looking for a new secretary.

"I said, 'I don't want to do secretary work,'" Moore recalled. "He said, 'Give it a shot.' 'Ok', I said, and he wrote me a letter of recommendation."

She got a call back from the President's Office that afternoon. It had been years since she had practised secretarial shorthand, and she was worried she'd be a bit rusty. But the skills came back quickly, and her leadership experience soon made her an invaluable asset at a key time in Dal's history.

Dalhousie was evolving rapidly in the late 1960s. Many buildings we take for granted now as stalwarts of campus life were mere holes in the ground when Moore walked to her office each morning. The Dalhousie Arts Centre and Dalplex were two spaces that sprung out of the ground while Moore handled the heavy administrative workload — made doubly complicated by Hicks' frequent trips to Ottawa to fulfill his duties as a Canadian senator.

"It was busy in those days, when he was a senator, a lot was happening at Dalhousie" she said. "Our office held it all together."

Even after her retirement Moore continued to work with Hicks, moving from their office in the administrative building — the one we now call the Henry Hicks Building — to his home office. She worked with him until the day he died in December 1990.

Moore, who passed away in early 2018 at the age of 100, looked back fondly on her time at Dalhousie. She remembered when denim jeans came into fashion, and when students started wearing long hair.

"It was nice being around all the young people. Dalhousie was wonderful, it was a big part of my life," she said with a laugh, "which is great because at the time I was hired it was the last place I wanted to work."

**1. James Moore**, son of **Samson Moore** (1730-1782) & **Martha (Margaret) Archibald** (abt 1735-abt 1782). Born on 9 Aug 1755 in Londonderry, Rockingham, New Hampshire. James died in Shubenacadie, NS, in 1818; he was 62.

Samson Moore was among the early settlers of Truro and was a Grantee of the township. He emigrated to Londonderry, New Hampshire, and from thence to Nova Scotia, in 1762. He was drowned in the Bay near Salter's Head, out of a boat, in 1782, aged 52 years (Miller). He married Martha Archibald before they left New Hampshire and they had seven children, one of whom was James. Martha was a sister of all of the Archibald's who came to Truro from Londonderry, New Hampshire.

James settled near the Shubenacadie River, at the carrying place, so called.
