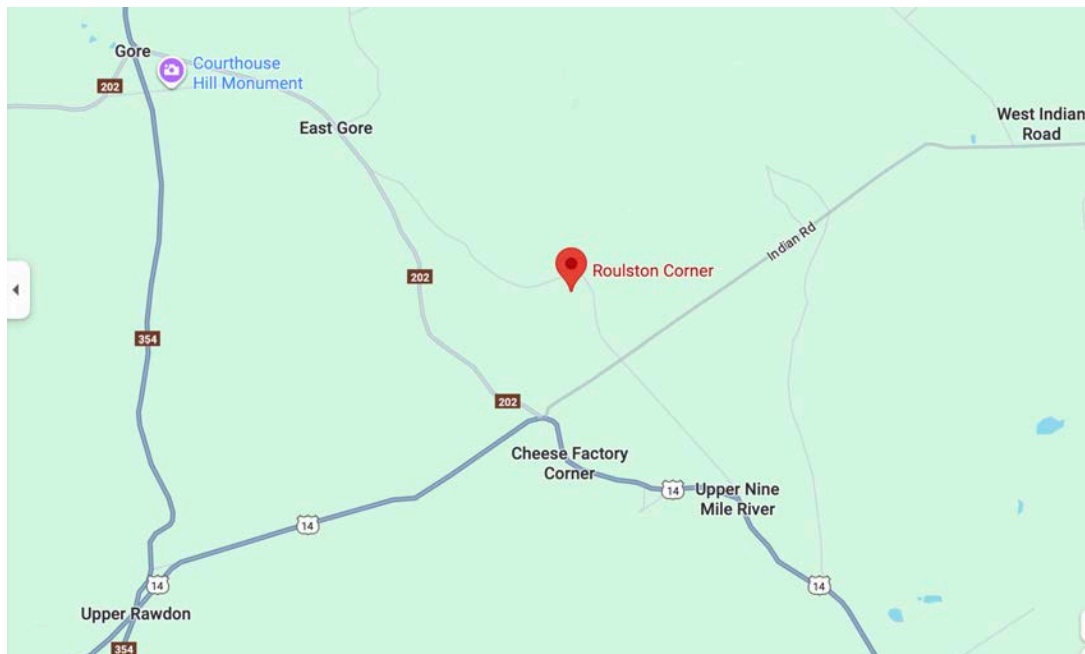

**1. Robert Roulston.** Born ca 1786 in Donegal, Ireland. Robert died in Nine Mile River, Douglas, NS, on 9 Nov 1860; he was 74. Buried in Nine Mile River Church Cemetery.

1827 census Windsor Road, Halifax County, Roulston, Robert 2 Males in the family, 5 Females in the family, 2 Labourers, 1 Servant, 10 Total, Manufacturing, Presbyterian, 20 Bushels Potatoes, 1 Tons of Hay, 1 Swine.

1838 census Rawdon Township, Roulston Robert Yeoman, no male children <6 years of age, 3 female children <6 years of age, no males <14 years of age, 2 females <14 years of age, 2 males >14 years of age but not head, 3 females >14 years of age, 11 Total in family.

*Note: if these are all family members, then several are unaccounted for in the public records.*

“In Memory of Robert Roulston, A native of Donegal, Ireland, immigrated to Nova Scotia 1812, Died Nov 9, 1860 Age 74 yrs” Nine Mile River Church Cemetery.

In 1819 when Robert was 33, he married **Mary Ann Gebhardt** in Halifax, NS. Mary Ann died in Nine Mile River, Douglas, NS on 6 Dec 1863. Buried in Nine Mile River, Hants Co., NS.

According to familysearch, she was born in Centre Rawdon.

1871 census Nine Mile River Roulston Robert 47 farmer Anna 31 Mary J 9 Frederick 7 Isabell 5 Eleanor 3 Minnie C 1.

On 8 May 1861 when Robert C. was 37, he married **Anna Jane Caldwell**, daughter of **John Parker Caldwell** (20 Mar 1810-9 Aug 1874) & **Isabel McPhee** (23 Oct 1810-28 Apr 1877), in Nine Mile River, Hants Co., NS. Born in 1840. Anna Jane died on 4 Nov 1886; she was 46.

On 21 Nov 1894 when Eleanor was 25, she married **James Edward Steck** in Boston, Mass. Born on 7 Aug 1865 in Milford Station, Hants Co., NS. James Edward died in Malden, Mass., USA, on 20 Aug 1959; he was 94. Buried in Glenwood Cemetery, Everett, Mass.

James E. Steck, 94, of Bartlett st., Malden, one-time owner of the Belmont Hill Spring Water Works in Belmont Park, Everett, died last night at Malden Hospital

after a brief illness. He was born in Milford, N.S., and came to Everett in 1885, where he resided until 1917, when he moved to Malden. He recently was given his "50" pin by the Palestine Lodge A.F. & A.M., Everett, and also was a member of the Everett Lodge of Odd Fellows and the Malden Methodist Church. He leaves a son, George, of Everett.

**3. Mary Sophia Roulston** (*Robert*<sup>1</sup>). Born on 7 Oct 1830. Mary Sophia died in Shubenacadie, Hants Co., NS, on 22 Sep 1907; she was 76.

Probably the daughter of Robert and Mary Roulston.

On 25 Feb 1851 when Mary Sophia was 20, she married **William Kingston Tanner** in Shubenacadie, Hants Co., NS. Born on 13 Nov 1823 in Cork, Ireland. William Kingston died in Shubenacadie, Hants Co., NS, on 5 Sep 1880; he was 56. Buried in Milford Station, Hants Co., NS.

In 1892 when Anna Jane was 32, she second married **Franklin Howell Yonker** in Philadelphia, PA. Born on 27 Jan 1860 in Pennsylvania. Franklin Howell died in Philadelphia, PA, on 6 Feb 1914; he was 54.

Agnes married **David Bernard Clark**. Born on 26 Dec 1849 in Milltown, Charlotte Co., NB.

According to familysearch, David Bernard Clark remarried Bertha May Moore (b. 6 Sep 1894 East Uniacke, d. 28 Sep 1971 Elmsdale) and had 8 children, born from 1913. She remarried Howard DeBlois Hutt (b. 4 Nov 1879 Chester Bason, d. 7 Jun 1948 McPhee's Corner), 13 Oct 1930 McPhhes Corner.

On 24 Jul 1866 when Archibald H. was 25, he married **Mary Fraser**, daughter of **James Fraser** (16 Sep 1799-1874) & **Christiana (Christie Ann) McPhee** (24 Aug 1805-), in Nine Mile River, NS. Born on 29 Mar 1843 in Nine Mile River, NS. Mary died in Braintree, Mass., on 26 Jun 1912; she was 69.

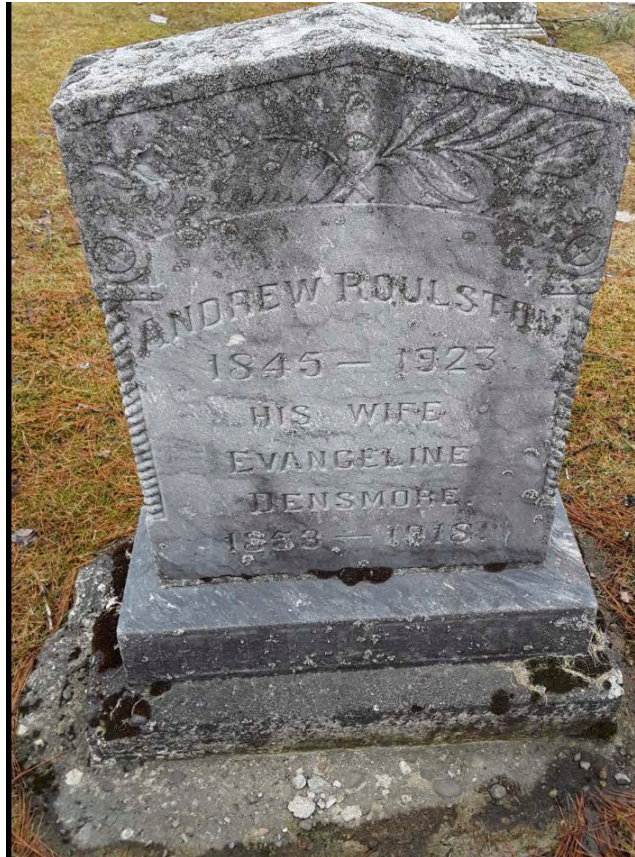

In 1890 when Frederick was 26, he married **Emma Caroline Britton**, daughter of **Henry Britton** (14 Feb 1831-21 Mar 1912) & **Eliza Jane McPhee** (20 Mar 1837-9 May 1922). Born on 15 Sep 1866. Emma Caroline died in Upper Nine Mile River, Hants Co., NS, on 13 May 1921; she was 54. Buried in East Gore Cemetery.

Residence: Gays River (1901).

Son of Donald and Catherine. Widower, age 34, when he married Caroline Tanner. (NS marriages)
